THE ORDER OF ISLINGTON NOMINATION FORM

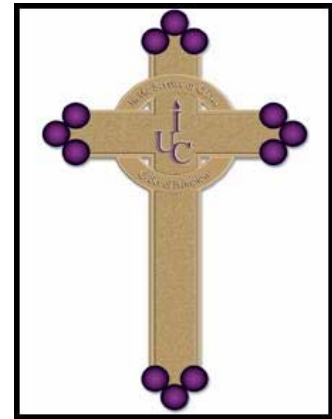

They may have served God through their work in Islington United Church, or through service to the local community, or through their contributions to Canada or the global community. Include written testimonials or any other materials that you think help to describe the person's service to God and that will assist the advisory council of Elders and staff in making its decision. Return your completed submission in a sealed envelope to the Elders' folder by the published deadline.

How Are the Recipients Chosen?

An advisory council made up of members of the Committee of Elders and the ministerial team and staff will review the nominations prayerfully and carefully and, on behalf of all the Elders, will invest new members in The Order of Islington. Those to be honoured will be presented formally with The Order of Islington and a certificate at an annual ceremony.
